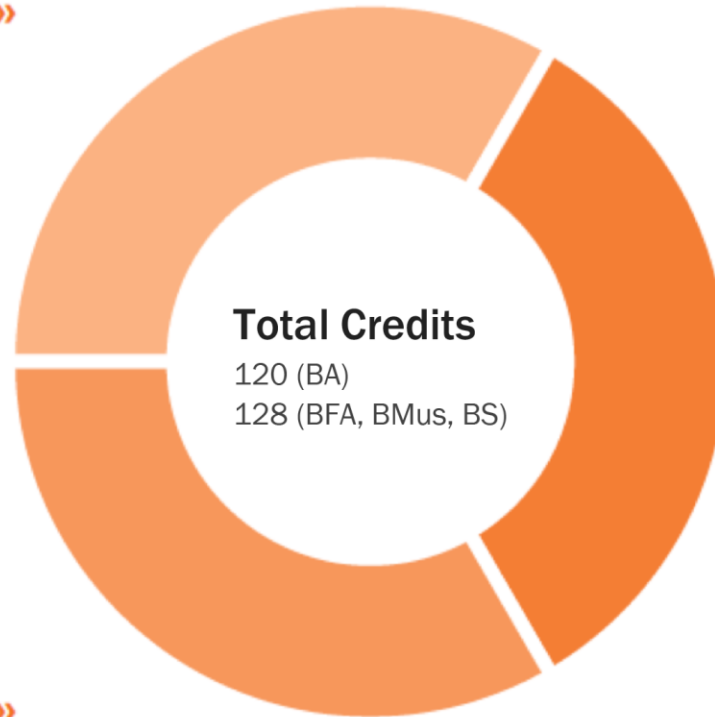
# COLUMBIA'S DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

# DEVELOPING YOUR GRADUATION PLAN



For a student seeking to graduate in 4 years...



Benchmark is 30-32 Credits Earned Per Year  
( $30 \times 4 = 120$  Credits)



12 Credits Minimum to be full-time but  
15-16 suggested to earn 30 per year



12-18 Credits in Fall and Spring is the range  
(same amount) for tuition



Typically suggest a balance of Core, Major, and  
CWE's each semester
