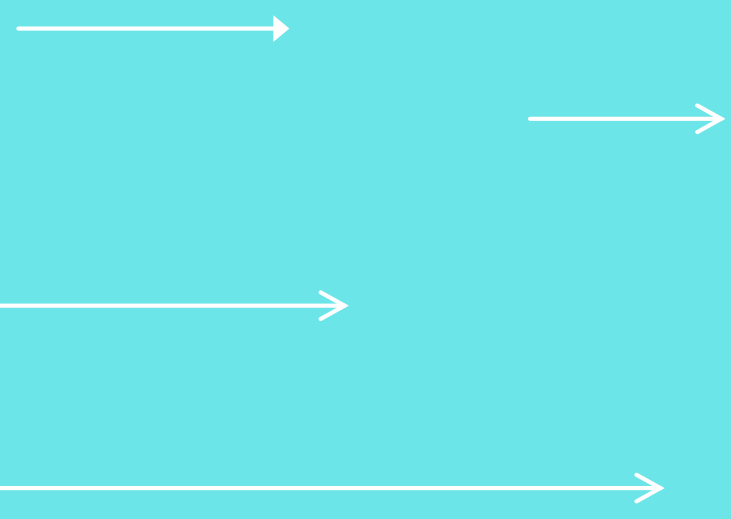

- Behavioral concerns in the classroom

Seven full-time licensed staff therapists, one admin,
Four graduate level interns

Goals

- Help students address their mental health concerns, increase their self-awareness and reach their goals
- Empower students to better manage challenging areas in their lives through providing high-quality mental health services or assisting with linkage to appropriate referrals

Services (in-person or virtual available)

- Up to 12 free individual counseling sessions per each academic year enrolled
- Therapy groups facilitated by staff in CS and SR each semester
- Referrals to on-campus departments and off-campus community resources
- Crisis intervention services to students who verbalize that they cannot keep themselves safe

- Investigate your insurance coverage over the summer to determine if/how it can be used in Chicago (out-of-state students)
- If you are currently taking a regularly prescribed medication, figure out your refill plan NOW so you aren't without medication.

SERVICES PROVIDED

- Rashes
- Pink eye
- Sore throat
- Women's Health (birth control pills, Depo injections), vaginal infections
- Depo injections
- Asthma exacerbation
- Muscle sprains/strains
- Ear infections/ear cleaning
- Urinary tract infections
- Common cold, flu & upper respiratory infections
- Immunizations (fee applies)
 - Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria & Pertussis) \$65
- Suture removal (but not placement)
- STI services and testing -monthly, by appointment only
- Testing: strep, pregnancy, urine dipstick, blood sugar, mono , and COVID-19
- Allergy injections (maintenance doses only; patient provides serum)



WE DO NOT PROVIDE

- Pap smears
- Complete physical exams
- Blood work/laboratory tests
- Suture placement (removal only)
- X-rays or other imaging services
- Management for chronic conditions
- Management for long -term medication
- Diagnosis or treatment for ADD or ADHD

NOTE: Office visits/evaluations are free. If medication is needed, a prescription will be given.

We do not stock medications in the office
