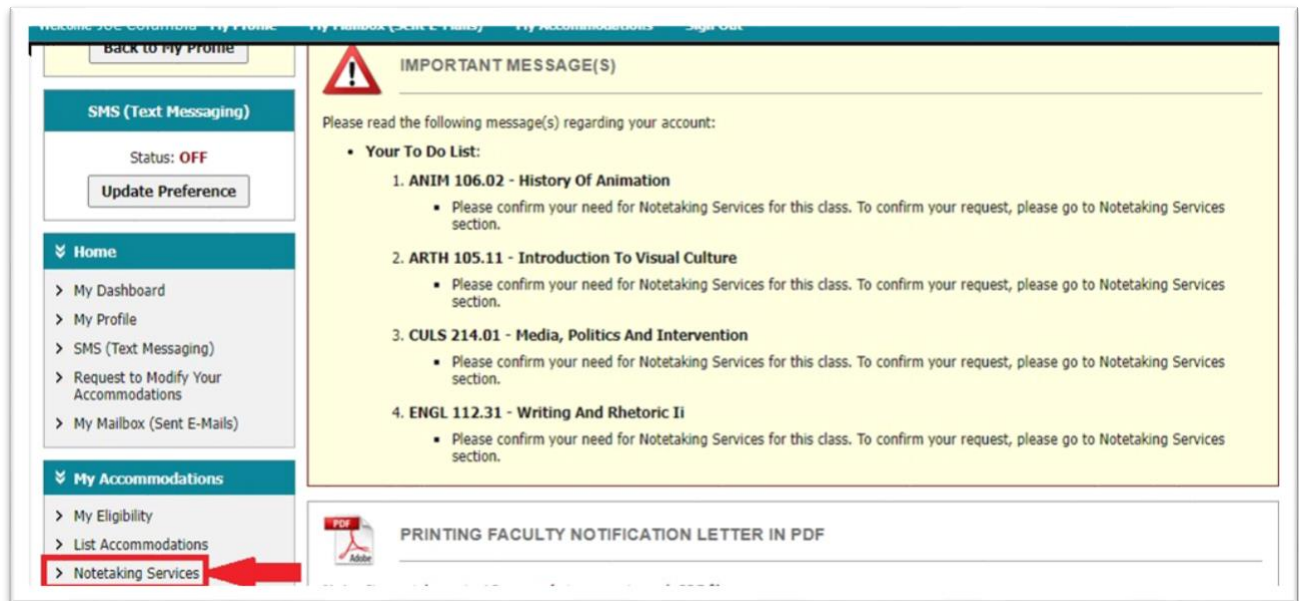


Confirming Your Need for a Notetaker

1. You may have *requested* notetaking, but **after the first week of classes you must *confirm*** it.
2. Some classes are asynchronous, meaning you can take notes at your own pace. This means you don't actually need a notetaker.
3. Your MySSD home page should look like the picture below. Click "Notetaking Services" in the bottom left-hand corner. If you need the link to get there, here it is:
