# Community Alert

**Armed Robberies** 001st District (Central) 012th District (Near West) 018th District (Near North) Alert #24-3-026 April 25, 2024

### About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to residents of the 001st, 012th, and 018th Districts of recent related Armed Robberies. In each of these incidents, the offenders arrived at location of incident in a vehicle. Offenders then exited vehicle and displayed multiple firearms at which time they proceeded to rob the victims of their personal belongings. Additionally, in several of the incidents, victims were battered by one of the offenders.

# About the Offenders:

Three African American Males, 15-20 years old, wearing dark-colored hooded sweatshirts and black ski masks. The vehicle used by the offenders is described as a silver 4-door sedan with a dark-colored painted passenger door.

#### What you can do:

- Be aware of these crimes and alert family and friends who live in the area.
- Be aware of your surroundings and free from distractions.
- If you are confronted by an assailant, try to remain calm.
- Pay special attention to suspicious individuals or vehicles in the area.
- Call 911 immediately if you are a victim or witness to a crime and provide a detailed description of the offender(s) including any vehicle description and license plate information.
- If approached by a witness to an incident, request they remain on the scene when possible or obtain contact information.
