Chicago Police are investigating a sexual assault and robbery that occurred near campus.

On November 14, 2015 at approximately 3:00 a.m. a woman was followed by a male from the CTA Red Line station at Harrison and State Street. The woman, who is not a Columbia student, reported she was robbed and sexually assaulted by the male.

The suspect is described as a male African American, about 25 year of age, 6 feet, average build wearing a black leather jacket, a black hoodie and light stoned washed jeans.

The case number is HY-500846 and if you have any information you are asked to contact the Area Central Detective Division at 312-747-8380.

Precautionary Measures:

- Always be in a full state of awareness of individuals around you and your surroundings.
- Report suspicious activity to the Chicago Police by dialing 911, followed by Campus Security at 312-369-1111.
- Buddy-Up and avoid walking or traveling on public transportation alone.
- Seek immediate shelter in a public establishment if an individual exhibits suspicious behavior, follows you or if you feel they have criminal intent.
