DePaul University's Office of Public Safety is investigating a criminal incident.

DePaul University reported that a DePaul student was walking near Congress and Wabash when he was approached from behind and incapacitated with a noxious substance on a cloth and dragged into an SUV. He stated he was sexually assaulted and robbed. He was able to get out of the vehicle and the offenders fled in an unknown direction.

- Always be in a full state of awareness of individuals around you and your surroundings.
- Report suspicious activity to the Chicago Police by dialing 911, followed by Campus Security at 312-369-1111.

- Seek immediate shelter in a public establishment if an individual exhibits suspicious behavior, follows you or if you feel they have criminal intent.
