Columbia College Chicago Community:

The Chicago Police Department is currently investigating a reported robbery that occurred in the 900 to 1100 block of South Wabash on August 14th at approximately 9:05 p.m. A citizen, stopped at a red light was approached by a group of young teens who reached into the passenger window of his vehicle and took his wallet and cell phone from the seat. The citizen began chasing the offenders on foot and one of the teens displayed a knife demanding more money. The offenders were described as six to seven African-American males, between 10-15 years of age. No clothing description is available.

Precautions:

- Always be in a full state of awareness of individuals around you and your surroundings.
- Report suspicious or criminal activity to the Chicago Police by dialing 911, followed by a call to Campus Security at 312-369-1111.
- Buddy-Up and avoid walking or traveling on public transportation alone.
- Seek immediate shelter in a public establishment if an individual exhibits suspicious behavior, follows you or if you feel they have criminal intent.
