The Chicago Police Department investigated an incident that occurred on the street in the vicinity of 1100 South Wabash on April 26, 2017, at approximately 11:45 a.m. The victim reported that she was approached by the offender, a stranger, and struck. Chicago Police officers were able to arrest the offender shortly after the incident occurred and he has been charged with a criminal offense.
