Columbia College Chicago Community:

The Chicago Police Department is currently investigating an attempt robbery that occurred in the 1400 block of South Wabash Avenue on June 6, 2017, at approximately 12:30 a.m. The victim reported that she was riding her bicycle southbound on Wabash when an unknown make and model black SUV pulled alongside. The offender reached out of the vehicle and attempted to take the victim's backpack. The victim fell to the ground and the vehicle continued southbound on Wabash.
