Purpose

- Provides outreach to students who are reported to be struggling, academic alerts, needing assistance
- Investigate and Resolve infractions of the Code of Student Conduct
- Coordinate student assistance among various campus offices and resources

Typical Concerns Addressed

- Working with instructors for absences
- Help with Institutional/Program questions
- Homelessness, food & financial insecurity
- Transitioning back to campus after brief absence (hospitalization)
- Challenges with fellow classmates
- Academic challenges
- Interpersonal conflicts
- Behavioral concerns in the classroom
