\*Tuition: J-Term & Spring faculty-led programs are considered part of Columbia College Chicago’s spring semester. Undergraduates who do not exceed the 18 credit hour limit for the term, including the credits associated with their faculty-led program, will have no additional tuition charges for their program. Undergraduates who do exceed the 18 credit hour limit for the term will pay for each additional credit over 18. Graduate students will pay per credit depending on their enrolled graduate program tuition rates. Summer faculty-led programs are part of the summer term. All students will pay for the number of credits associated with the course. Please review the [current tuition expenses](#) for up-to-date pricing.

\*\*Overseas Health Insurance: Only applicable to international faculty-led programs. Global Education enrolls you in our comprehensive international emergency insurance program. This is mandatory. The cost of the insurance will be billed to your student account. A good estimate is around \$50. Very rarely, your special course fee may include this insurance cost.

Non-refundable deposits: All programs will require a non-refundable deposit. Non-refundable deposits are \$750 for international programs, and \$500 for domestic programs. Non-refundable deposits are due one week from acceptance into the program. This is not an additional fee – it will be applied to your student account approximately 10 days prior to the program start date.
