About the crimes:

This alert gives notice to residents in the 1st District of recent robbery incidents. Unknown offender(s) approach the victim on the street or sidewalk and take victim's property with use of force. In most of the incidents, the offender(s) use a motorized bike/scooter when approaching the victims and to flee.

About the Crimes:

This alert gives notice to citizens in the 001st District of recent similar robbery incidents occurring in the month of September. In both occurrences, multiple offenders approached the victims' and take property by force.

 detailed description of the offender(s) including any physical/clothing
 identifiers
- If approached by a witness to an incident, request they remain on scene when possible or obtain contact information
- . Never pursue a fleeing assailant, provide the information to the police
