Crime Advisory

The Chicago Police Department is investigating two incidents:

The first incident occurred on November 2 in the vicinity of 1306 South Michigan Avenue at approximately 3:15 p.m. An individual was approached by an unknown offender who told the victim to get out of his way and then struck him with his fist. The offender continued walking on.

The second incident occurred on November 3 near 1112 South Wabash Avenue at approximately 8:15 p.m. An individual was in the alley when an offender approached, displayed a handgun and demanded the individual's personal property. The offender fled to a vehicle with another individual seated inside. The vehicle then drove north in the ally.

General Safety Precautions

- Remain alert.
- Buddy-up: travel in groups through well-lit and high-traffic areas after dark.
- Seek immediate shelter in a public establishment if you feel unsafe.
- Call 911 immediately if you are a victim or witness to a crime and provide a
 detailed description of the offender(s) including any physical/clothing identifiers in
 addition to any vehicle description and license plate information.
- If approached by a witness to an incident, request they remain on scene when possible or obtain contact information.
- Never pursue a fleeing assailant, provide information to the police.
- Inform Campus Security of any crime or safety concern.
