Crime Advisory

The Chicago Police Department is investigating an incident that occurred in the Grant Park skate park near Roosevelt Road and Michigan Avenue on August 31 at approximately 2:45 p.m.

Two individuals placed a backpack with their personal possessions on the ground and moved a distance away. An offender reportedly took the backpack, according to a witness. A person in possession of the backpack was confronted by the victims in the vicinity of Roosevelt Road and Wabash Avenue and returned some of the property but then became physically violent by punching, grabbing, and implying he had a weapon before fleeing.

General Safety Precautions

- Remain alert.
- Buddy-up: travel in groups through well-lit and high-traffic areas after dark.
- Seek immediate shelter in a public establishment if you feel unsafe.
- Call 911 immediately if you are a victim or witness to a crime and provide a detailed description of the offender(s) including any physical/clothing identifiers in addition to any vehicle description and license plate information.
- If approached by a witness to an incident, request they remain on scene when possible or obtain contact information.
- Never pursue a fleeing assailant, provide information to the police.
- Inform Campus Security of any crime or safety concern.
