The Office of Campus Safety and Security received a report of a **sexual assault** that occurred March 19th in a residential facility involving an individual known to the reporting party. At this time, a decision has been made by the reporting party to not file a report to law enforcement. Campus Safety and Security, however, want to take this opportunity to inform on precautionary measures to avoid acquaintance sexual assaults.

PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES

- Be mindful that alcohol and drugs are often used to make someone vulnerable to sexual assault.
- Be alert to people who pressure you or others to use a drug or consume alcohol.
- Don't leave your drink unattended while talking, dancing, using the restroom, or making a phone call. If you've left your drink alone, just get a new one.
- Don't engage in sexual activities without consent from your partner. Someone incapacitated due to alcohol or drugs cannot consent to sexual activity.
- If you believe a crime has been committed call the police by dialing 911, followed by a call to Campus Security at (312) 369- 1111.
