Columbia College Chicago Community:

The Chicago Police Department is investigating an incident that occurred on March 12 at approximately 6:15 pm in the 800 block of South Wabash.

The victim, a male, had an interaction with a group of four other males earlier in the day. The group spotted the male on the street later in the evening and an altercation ensued. The dispute escalated and the male victim was stabbed. The victim is currently receiving medical treatment.

The offenders are described as four younger male Hispanics and they fled the area in a silver four door automobile. None of the involved individuals are believed to have any affiliation with the College.

Precautions:

- Always be in a full state of awareness of individuals around you and your surroundings.
- Report suspicious activity to the Chicago Police by dialing 911, followed by Campus Security at 312-369-1111.
- Buddy-Up and avoid walking or traveling on public transportation alone.
- Seek immediate shelter in a public establishment if an individual exhibits suspicious behavior, follows you or if you feel they have criminal intent.
