### ROBBERY 1st District (Central)

**About the Crime:**

This alert gives notice to citizens residing in the 1<sup>st</sup> (Central) District of robbery related incidents during the months of August and September. Offenders are confronting citizens on the sidewalk, displaying a semi- automatic handgun and demanding cell phones, wallets or contents of purses. Offenders are then demanding that victims unlock their cellphones and reset their settings to factory status. Offenders are also threatening violence, demanding PIN numbers of victim's bank cards.

**Incident Times and Locations:**

- 900 block of S. Michigan Ave., on August 29, 2016 at 1:00 a.m.
- 1200 block of S. Lake Shore Dr., on August 31, 2016 at 12:30 a.m.
- 500 block of S. Columbus Dr., on September 1, 2016 at 1:15 a.m.

**About the Offenders:**

- **HZ411348:** Male, Black, 15-17 years old, 5'7", 150 lbs., dark complexion, **black baseball hat with yellow writing.** Male, Black 15-17 years old, 5'7", 160 lbs., dark complexion, black hooded sweatshirt, blue jeans.
- **HZ415646:** Male, Black, 17-22 years old, 5'6", 160 lbs., dark complexion, **black baseball hat with Batman logo.** Male, Black, 17-22 years old, 6'00", 150 lbs, dark complexion, black pants.

**What you can do:**

- Always be aware of your surroundings
- Report suspicious activity immediately
- If you are confronted by an assailant remain calm
- Remember any unique physical characteristics (scars, limp, acne, teeth, etc.)
- Never pursue a fleeing assailant, provide the information to the police
- If approached by a witness to the incident, request contact information
- Dial 9-1-1 immediately and remain on scene when possible
