Crime Advisory

The Chicago Police Department is investigating an incident that occurred on November 25, at approximately 4:15 p.m. The incident began near 600 S. Michigan Avenue and concluded near Roosevelt and Michigan.

A verbal interaction allegedly transpired near 600 S. Michigan Avenue between occupants of two different vehicles and a pistol was displayed. The vehicles continued southbound on Michigan Avenue to the second location where a physical altercation occurred. The weapon was reportedly used as a blunt instrument to strike the victim. None of the involved parties have any known affiliation with the college.

- Do not engage in financial transactions with individuals on the street that you do not know.
