Crime Advisory

The Chicago Police Department is investigating two incidents that occurred on October 4, 2021 between 6:40 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.

In the first incident at 66 East Harrison Street, one individual was approached by a group of three, a weapon was displayed and a cell phone was taken. In the second incident near Ida B. Wells Drive and Michigan Avenue, a cell phone was taken from an individual by a group of three but ultimately returned upon request.
