About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to residents of the 001st District of three recent cases involving victims that were attacked by a male black, possibly homeless from the area, in his 30's, 5'09" – 5'11" with either dread style hair or wearing a bandana that may look like dreads. In two of these cases it appears the offender approached the victims from behind and struck them with an unknown object. In the other incident the offender approached the victim, grabbed her from behind and stabbed her three (3) times.

Incident times and locations:

- 500 block of S Franklin on 10 June 2021 at approximately 9:31 pm.
- 0-100 block of E Congress Pkwy on 13 June 2021 at approximately 7:14 am.
- 400 block of S Wacker Dr. on 19 June 2021 at approximately 3:38 pm.

About the Offender:

The offender is a male black, possibly homeless from the area, in his 30's, 5'09" – 5'11" with either dread style hair or wearing a bandana that may look like dreads.

What you can do:

- Always be aware of your surroundings
- Report Suspicious activity immediately
- · If you are confronted by and assailant, remain calm
- · Remember any unique physical characteristics (i.e., scars, limp, acne, teeth, etc.)
- · Never pursue a fleeing assailant, provide the information to the police
- If approached by a witness to the incident, request contact information
- Dial 9-1-1 immediately and remain on scene when possible
